

WHEN DISASTER STRIKES YOUR HIGH-TECH EQUIPMENT**DO**

Disconnect All Equipment From Power Source

DO NOT

Start Up Equipment, Not Even For Testing

FIRE

- Disconnect equipment from ALL power sources, including backup batteries and uninterruptible power supplies (UPS). At power panels, remove fuses and place tape over circuit breakers to keep them in the “off” position.
- Open windows and use fans to remove smoke.
- Remove portable equipment to clean, dry area.
- Where building Repairs are underway, protect the equipment with plastic drop cloths and run dehumidifiers beneath the shelter.
- Prevent further spread of smoke, soot and/or water contamination from the fire source to areas containing equipment.

WATER

- Immediately Disconnect equipment from ALL power sources, including backup batteries and uninterruptible power supplies (UPS). At power panels, remove fuses and place tape over circuit breakers to keep them in the “off” position.
- If water enters through the ceiling, protect the equipment with plastic drop cloths and run dehumidifiers beneath the shelter.
- Vacuum and wipe water from walls, floors, sub-floors, heating ducts, etc.
- Remove all wet carpeting, furniture and drapes.
- Turn on the heating system and/or dehumidifiers to speed up drying.
- Critical metallic surfaces or machinery and work-in-progress should be temporarily protected with water-displacement oil.

INDUSTRIAL CONTAMINANTS

- Disconnect all dust sensitive equipment from power sources
- Do not operate any dust-contaminated equipment.
- Seal off the area from further dust infiltration and eliminate the dust source.
- Change the air filters on any equipment that must continue to operate before decontamination.
- Keep equipment dry wherever fire-extinguisher powder is present.
- Fire extinguishing agents are very abrasive and when they mix with moisture in the ambient air will lead to corrosion. Professionally decontaminate as soon as possible
